HARRIS REVIEW

Slot Management

- Prioritise new entrants
- New compliance measures
- Increased scrutiny of cancellation data
- Align better with WASG

Regional Access – ‘Ring Fence’

- Expand “regional” to regional locations outside NSW
- Shorten peak period
- Transition regional slots outside new peak into regular slots

Movement Cap

- 2-hour recovery window up to 87 movements
- Retain 80 movement cap
- Reporting against cap on hourly basis

GOVERNMENT REFORMS

- No change to curfew
- Implement a 2-hour recovery period up to 85 movements per hour.
- Reduce peak from 6-11am / 3-8pm to 7-11am / 5-8pm
- Regional carriers can apply for non-regional slots in peak
- Re-timing of 'stranded' slots
- Increasing flexibility of 'size of aircraft test'
- Addressing slot misuse and strengthening compliance regime
- Competitive tender for Slot Manager

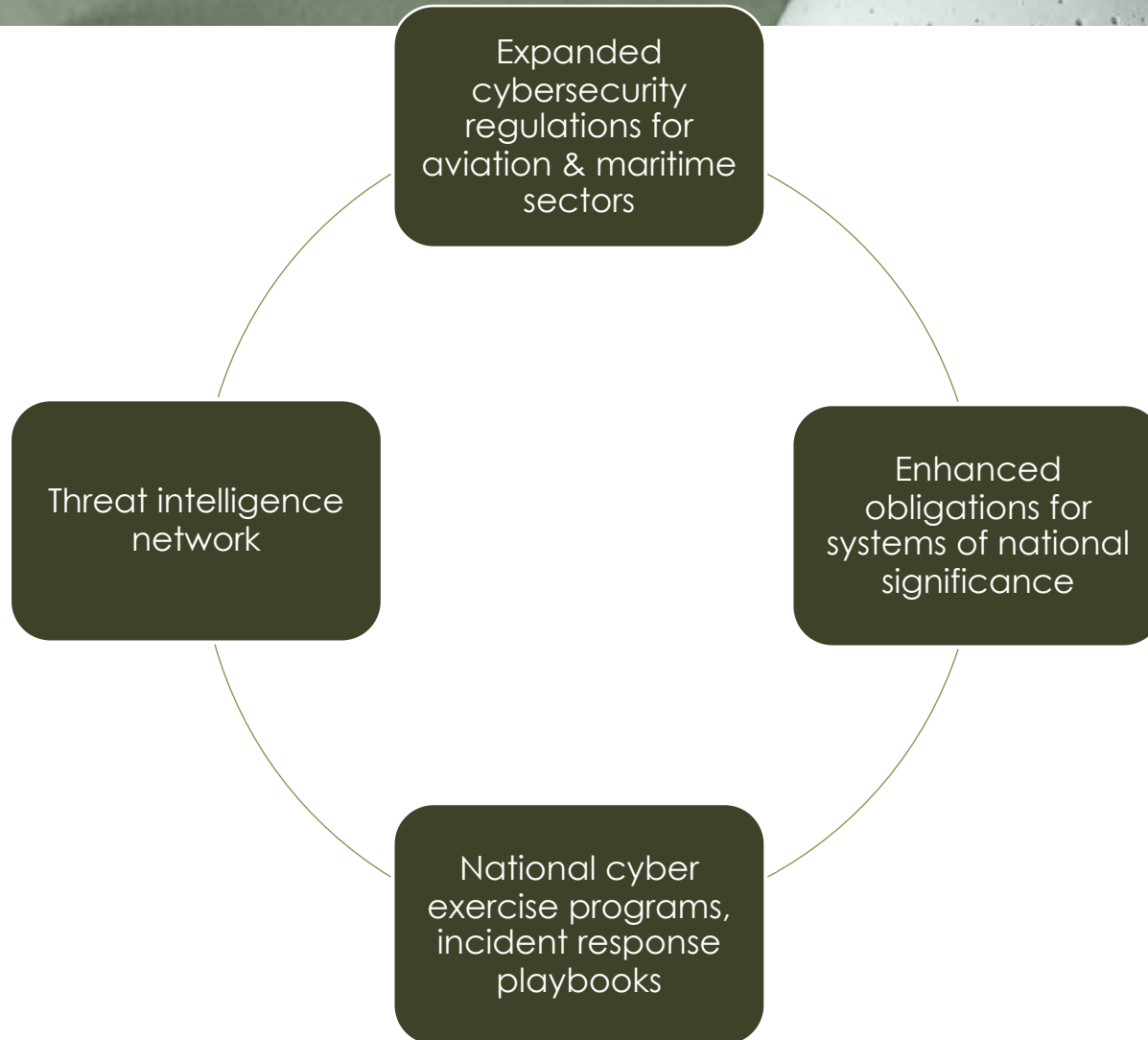
